Timing

- The need of reviewers to join the process as early as possible.
- Once the models/interventions are finalized then reviewing the economic aspect only might not be of great help.
- Project timelines not always conducive to pausing for review.
- Time zones.

Data sharing

- Some are open to share reviewers and very open-minded to consider the suggestions of reviewers.
- Challenges of review without always knowing the full background and parameters of the modeling and/or costing work.
- Need to be respectful of country data sharing constraints.

BRR materials

- The report template is either not used or just partially used.
- The categories of initial, interim and final report might mean different things for different countries.
- Can create a burden on modelling team if they have to produce one more report just for the ease of reviewers.
- Challenge of getting enough detail to review, without burdening modeling team with questions.
